Rev. Justin Richter, the Director of Global Missions for our denomination, provided us with an email address for Rev. Marja del Socorro Pejendino in Guatemala; she attended the Missions Conference that was held at our church back in June of 2022. There is a small transaction fee (2.9% plus \$0.30) for all online donations; the giver has the option of covering that fee when making a gift to the church.

Inclement Weather Policy

For activities during the week, such as Choir Practice or Friendship Club outings, if the Knox County School System cancels school or dismisses early for snow and ice, our activities are automatically canceled. Hopefully, those typically involved in these activities will receive a telephone call, text, or email confirming that cancelation.
